Travel Grace Period Following the completion of your program, the period defined on the Form I-20 for an F1 student, on the Form DS-2019 for J-1 student. USCIS allows participants a 60-day for F1 student and a 30-day for J-1 scholar travel period commonly referred to as the "Grace Period." During this grace period, participants are no longer in F1/J-1 status and are under the jurisdiction of the USCIS. The USCIS grants this period to allow participants to settle their affairs and to prepare to return to their home countries. Program participants may no longer continue and/or complete program activities, nor may they work.
