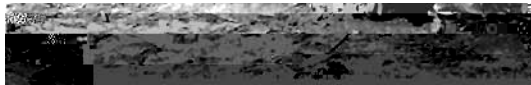

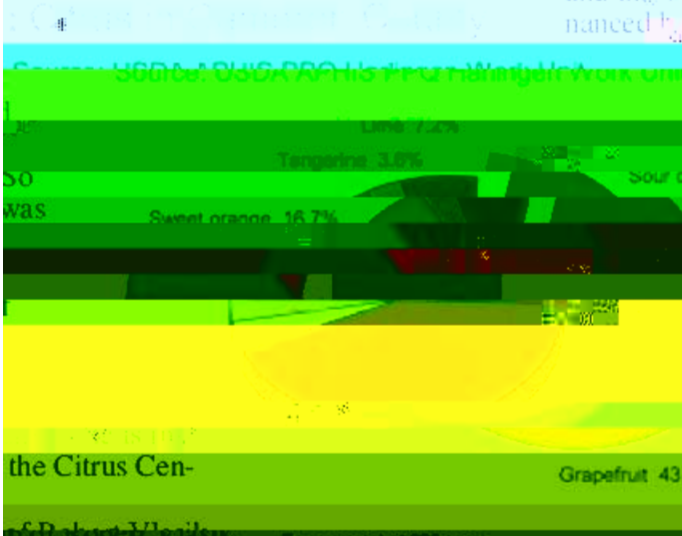

leafminer, is of considerable concern, and since doorway citrus trees are diverse in both their types (see table below) and origins, they can be a source of various citrus diseases. So far, we have tested over 800 samples and only one was found to be infected. This is a very low incidence.

Again, no infected samples were detected. This ongoing observation has been made in some 22% of all doorway trees are sour orange, probably from rootstocks that grew back after the 1989 freeze. Some growers have successfully topworked such trees to other varieties.

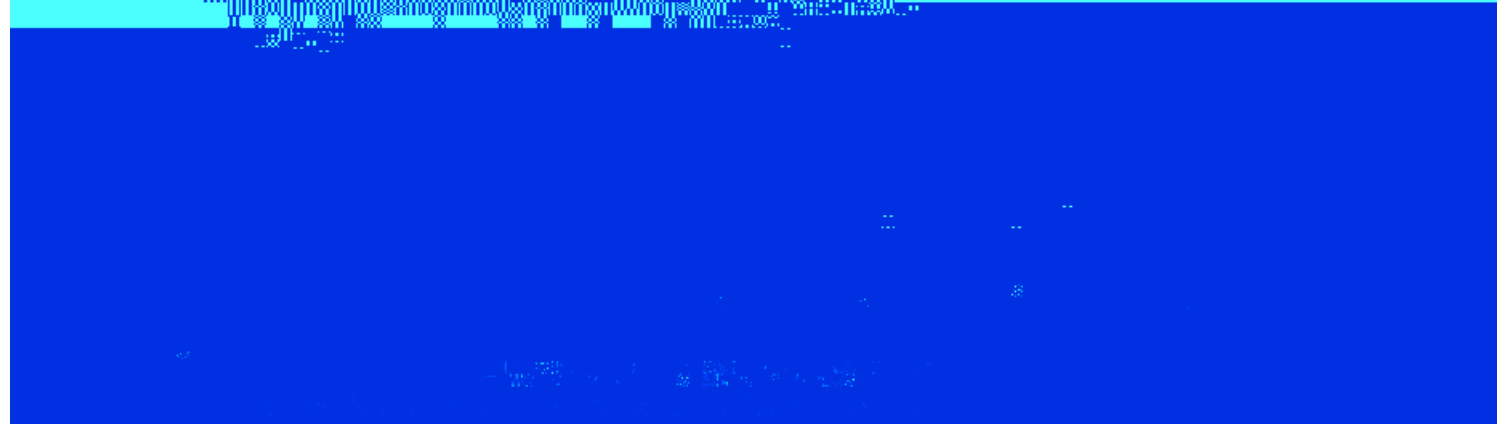
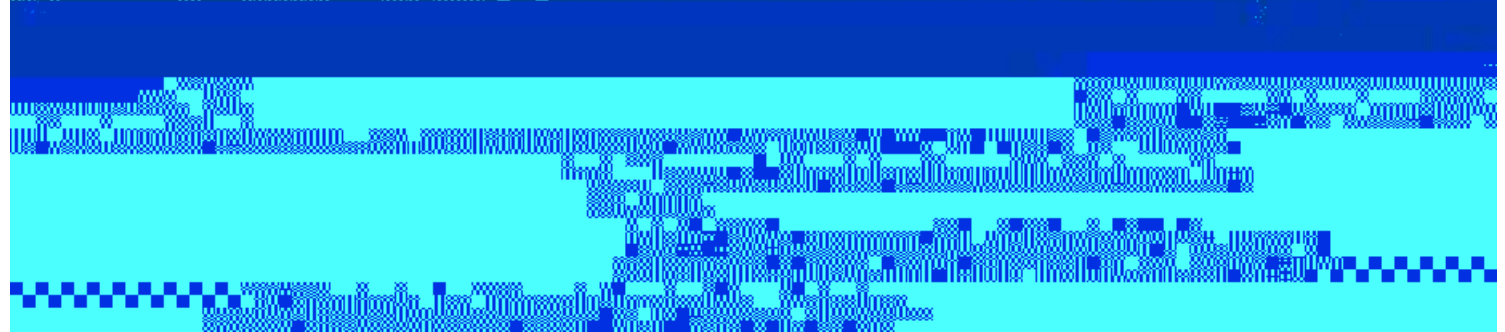

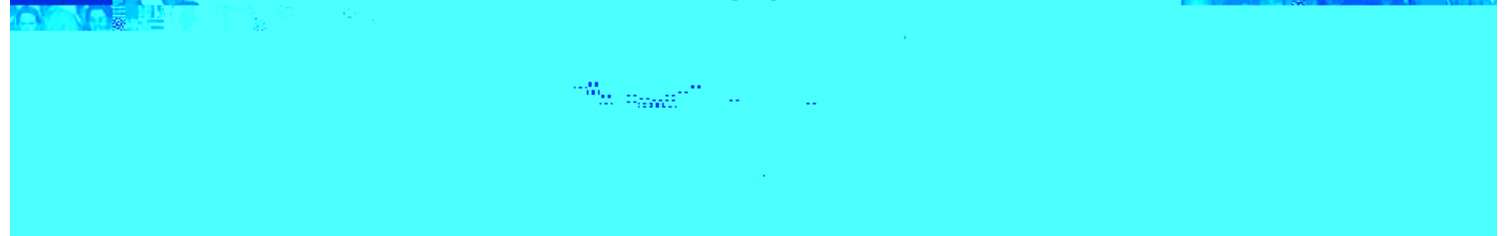
