- Hearing health is essential to your lifelong success as a musician.
- Your hearing can be permanently damaged by loud sound including music. Technically, this is called Noise-Induced Hearing Loss (NIHL). Such danger is constant.
- Noise-induced hearing loss is generall preventable. You must avoid overexposure to loud sounds, especially for long periods of time.
