

Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA), HEERF II Student Aid Portion Plan

Texas A&M University Kingsville received additional Higher Education Emergency Relief Funds II (HEERF II) through the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA), 2021, Public Law 116-260, signed into law by President Donald Trump on Dec. 27, 2020. The Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund I (HEERF I) was initially established by the CARES Act, which was passed by Congress and signed by President Trump on March 27, 2020.

1. Texas A&M University Kingsville acknowledges that the university signed and returned to the Department of Education the Certification and Agreement. The institution further certifies it will use a minimum of 50% of the funds, or \$3,543,714, received under Section 314(a)(1) of the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA), 2021, Public Law 116-260, signed into law by President Donald Trump on Dec. 27, 2020. The institution further certifies that all Title IV eligible students have been affected by the pandemic and either needed assistance with cost of attendance (COA) or other educational expenses.
