B. Presentations

<u>Five</u> refereed original research presentations. One of these presentations must be as 1st author/co-author for refereed original research at the national/international level. The remainder of this criterion can be met by presenting:

- 1. refereed original research at the national/international level, where
 - a. each 1st author/co-author presentation counts as 1 presentation.⁵
 - b. each 2nd author presentation counts as 1/2 presentation.
 - c. each 3rd author/later presentation counts as 1/3 presentation, unless the 1st author is a student investigator for whom the faculty member served as primary faculty mentor, then it counts as 1/2 presentation.
- 2. refereed original research at the state/regional level, where
 - a. each 1st author/co-author presentation counts as 1/2 presentation. ⁵
 - b. each 2nd author presentation counts as 1/3 presentation.
 - c. each 3rd author/later presentation counts as 1/4 presentation, unless the 1st author is a student investigator for whom the faculty member served as primary faculty mentor, then it counts as 1/3 presentation.
- 3. non-refereed research at the non-local level with a student as primary investigator that is not subsequently presented as a refereed presentation, where
 - a. each presentation as primary faculty mentor counts as 1/2 presentation (national/international) or 1/3 presentation (state/regional).
 - b. each presentation associate faculty investigator counts as 1/4 presentation.
