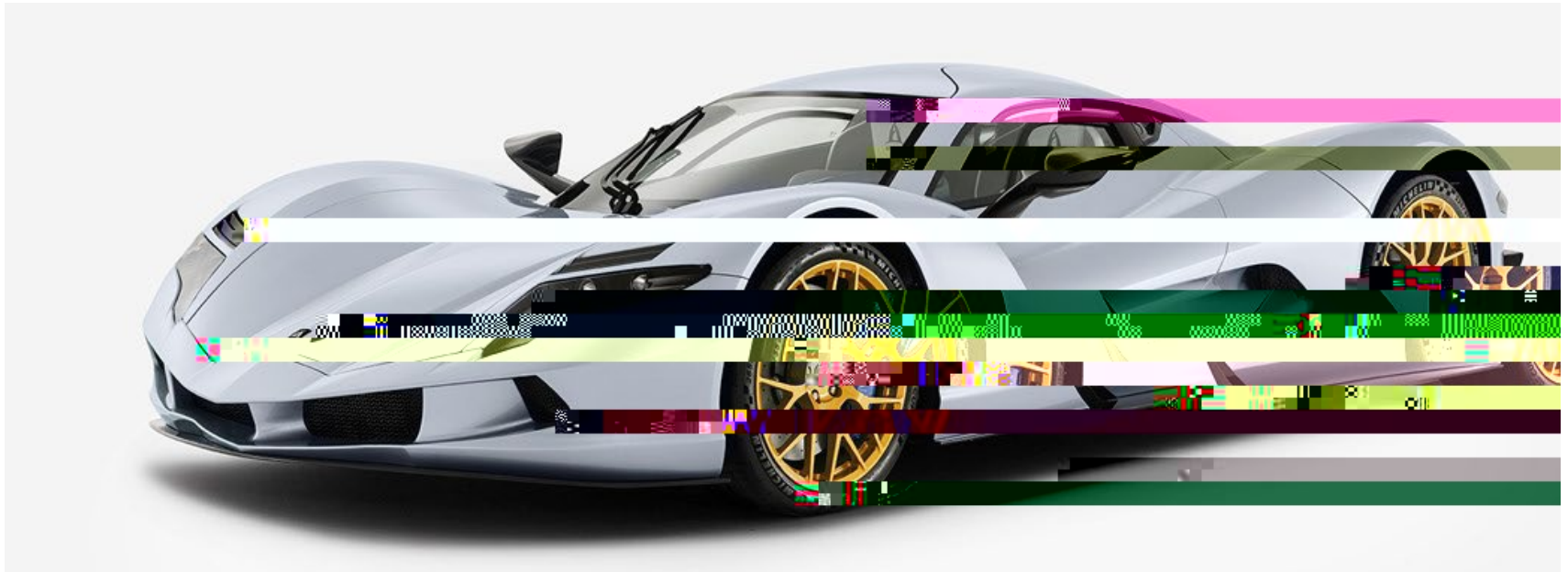

Standards in Manufacturing
