Purpose

The purpose of this procedure is to establish rules for governing wireless networking at TAMUK. This procedure limits interference with the University's network infrastructure, promotes greater security in campus networking, and supports the academic mission of the University in order to provide reliable and secure veiseInetwork access.

Audience

This procedure applies to wireless network users at TAMUK.

Wireless Access Procedure

- 1. Management of Radio Frequencies
 - a. TAMUK reserves the right to govern unlicensed radio frequencies within its boundaries. iTech is responsible for managing these radio frequencies and may restrict the use of any devices that can cause interference in the unlicensed radio frequency ranges. These include cordless phones, microwave ovens, and high voltage audio speakers.
 - b. iTech is solely responsible for providing wireless networking services on campus. No other department may deploy wireless network access points or other wireless service on campus. Personal or departmental wireless access points are strictly prohibited.
