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## **Introduction**

and/or pyrotechnics except for the use of paraffin wax candles at ceremonies or banquets.

4. These procedures shall not apply to those flame effects used as part of TAMUK approved teaching and research.

## 2. RESPONSIBILITIES

a. The Campus Fire Marshal shall:

1. Receive and process applications for the use of flame effects and/or pyrotechnics at TAMUK.
2. Reviewing and approving proposed use of flame effects and/or pyrotechnics.
3. Issue approval permit for the use of flame effects and/or pyrotechnics.
4. Inspect prior to and/or during the proposed event or activity as necessary to ensure that all NFPA and State of Texas codes and standards are met.
5. Interpret and clarify the requirements of this policy.
