

**SUMMER 2019 GRADUATION PROFILE
TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY – KINGSVILLE**

The SUMMER graduating class of 2019 at TAMUK consisted of 298 graduates. All of them received a single degree each. This makes a total of 298 degrees for SUMMER 2019. Out of 298 degrees granted, there are 136 bachelor’s degrees, 154 master’s degrees, and 8 doctoral degrees.

Of the 297 graduates, 216 (72%) were from Texas and 14 (5%) were from other states when they first entered the university, including California (3), Pennsylvania (2), Arizona (1), Connecticut (1), Georgia (1), Idaho (1), Kansas (1), Louisiana (1), Minnesota (1), South Carolina (1) and Washington (1). 68 (23%) were from other countries or regions, including India (30), Saudi Arabia (15), Kuwait (11), Mexico (4), Nigeria (3), Bangladesh (1), Iran (1), Nepal (1), Netherlands (1), and Niger (1).

The most frequent county of origin of in-state graduates was Nueces (36), followed by Hidalgo (30), Kleberg (26), Harris (16), and Cameron (13).

Of the graduating class, 174 (59%) were minority students. 100 (74%) of the bachelor’s, 73 (48%) of the master’s, and 2 (25%) of the doctoral degree recipients were minority students.

Of the graduating class, 138 (46%) were female. 54 (40%) of the bachelor’s, 78 (52%) of the master’s and 5 (63%) of doctoral degree recipients were female.

Of the 136 undergraduates, 71 (52%) entered the university as first-time freshmen and 65 (48%) entered as transfer students. Of the 71 first-time freshmen, 20 (28%) took at least one developmental course. 2 (3%) of the 65 transfer students took at least one developmental course.

Of the 298 graduates, four were full-time university employees. Three of them received a master degree each and the other was awarded a bachelor’s degree.
