SUMMER 2021 GRADUATION PROFILE TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY – KINGSVILLE

The SUMMER graduating class of 2021 at TAMUK consisted of 288 graduates or degrees. Out of 288 degrees granted, there are 134 bachelor's degrees, 146 master's degrees, and 8 doctoral degrees.

Of the 288 graduates, 249 (86%) were from Texas and 10 (3%) were from other states when they first entered the university, including California (2), Georgia (2), Alabama (1), Illinois (1), Minnesota (1), New Jersey (1), Virginia (1) and Washington (1). 29 (10%) were from other countries or regions, including India (16), Kuwait (6), Ghana (2), Nigeria (2), Dominican Republic (1), Nepal and Pakistan (1).

The most frequent county of origin of in-state graduates was Hidalgo (37), followed by Nueces (36), Kleberg (35), Cameron (33), and Harris (13).

Of the graduating class, 209 (73%) were minority students. 102 (76%) of the bachelor's, 102 (70%) of the master's, and 5 (63%) of the doctoral degree recipients were minority students.

Of the graduating class, 155 (54%) were female. 62 (46%) of the bachelor's, 89 (61%) of the master's and 4 (50%) of doctoral degree recipients were female.
