3.2 Any individual, university organization, or political party desiring to use TAMUK facilities for campaign or related political evermitsust make a formal request to the President's Chief of Staff. The use of TAMUK facilities for campain or related political events requires rental fees as well as charges for services utilized by the candidate in accordance with fee schedules and procedures applicable to all non-university entities using university acilities and services. Requests that can be reasonably and safely accommodated without detracting from the purpose and operations of the university will be consider to the purpose and operations.
