1. SCOPE AND LIMITATIONS

- 1.1 Areas in which smoking is prohibited:
 - 1.1.1 Smoking (the use or carrying of a lighted pipecigar, cigarette, tobaccoecigarette, and any other type of nicotine delivery systems moking substances prohibited on campus.
 - 1.1.2 The use of cigaettes, cigars, pipes, all forms of smokeless tobacco (chewing tobacco, snuff, dip, or any other product that contains tobacco), and any other smoking devices that use tobacco such as garette is also specifically prohibited on any TAMUK property.
 - 1.1.3 University student artists or actors who participate in authorized performances will be allowed to smoke as part of an artistic production provided that appropriate disposal receptacles and smoke filtration units are available and the audience is informed pride the performance.
